DECEMBER 2007 QTR KEY POINTS

The GRT figures reported from the referenced source are sorted by the filing date on which employers file their Gross Revenue Tax with the Bureau of Revenue, Customs & Taxation and may not reflect the exact values reported by the National Treasury which is responsible for tax collection.

- A total of approximately \$2.8 million dollars in business gross revenue tax (GRT) were collected in the 4th quarter of 2007.
- An annual comparison shows that the level of GRT collected has risen 13.1% from the same period last year. *The Manufacturing industry seems to have risen by a whopping 236%, however, this may be due to classification differences when categorizing companies into different industries.*
- A total of approximately \$10.2 million dollars in GRT have been collected in 2007. Last year, a total of nearly \$9.9 million in Gross Revenue Taxes were collected, which means there was around 3% growth between 2006 and 2007.
